Topic: His Biography: “Churchill – Walking With Destiny”

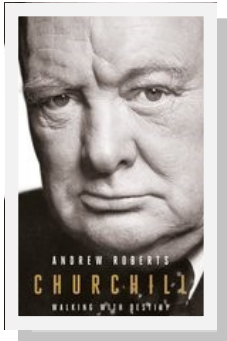


Dear Friends::

Our Guest Speaker: ANDREW ROBERTS



Andrew Roberts has spent nearly thirty years researching, writing and broadcasting extensively about both Churchill and the Second World War. His first book, *The Holy Fox*, was a biography of Churchill's foreign secretary Lord Halifax, and since then he has published – amongst others – *Eminent Churchillians*; *Hitler and Churchill: Secrets of Leadership*; *A History of the English Speaking Peoples Since 1900*; *Masters and Commanders: How Roosevelt, Churchill, Marshall and Alanbrooke Won the War in the West 1941-45*, and *The Storm of War: A New History of the Second World War*.

Roberts has won the Wolfson Prize for History, is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Literature, the Lehrman Institute Distinguished Lecturer at the New-York Historical Society and the Roger and Martha Mertz Visiting Research Fellow at the Hoover Institution at Stanford University.
