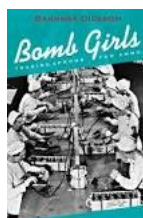
A LITTLE KNOWN CANADIAN WWII STORY WAS THE OUTPUT OF A PLANT IN SCARBOROUGH, ONTARIO, WHICH PRODUCED MORE THAN 256 MILLION MUNITIONS; MAKING IT CANADA'S MOST INDUSTRIOUS WARTIME FACTORY. THE GENERAL ENGINEERING COMPANY (GECO) PLANT OCCUPIED A 346-ACRE CAMPUS, EMPLOYED OVER 20,000 WORKERS, PREDOMINATELY WOMEN, AND HANDLED HIGH EXPLOSIVES AND VOLATILE GUNPOWDER; TASKS AS IMPORTANT TO THE WINNING OF THE WAR AS FACED BY THE MILITARY ON THE FRONT LINES.
